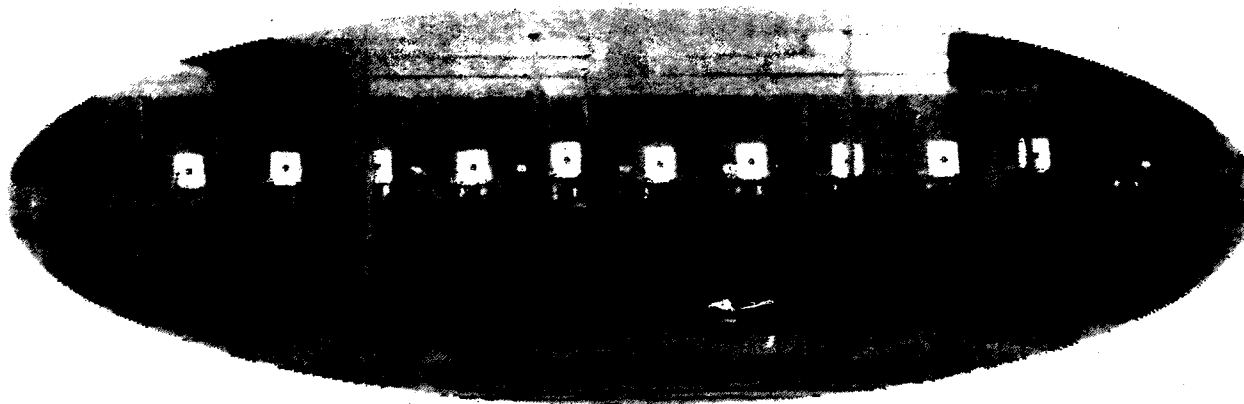

ENTRIES: Due to the range limitations, the total number of competitors is limited to 16.

LOCATION: The LAR&R range is in So. El Monte, approximately 12 miles east of downtown Los Angeles. Take Rosemead Blvd. south from the San Bernardino Freeway (I-10) or north from the Pomona Freeway (I-60) to Whittier Narrows Park entrance on the west side of the road, immediately north of the I-60 freeway. In the park, go to the right and around the park road until it dead ends. Go left to the range between the BMX bicycle race track and the model airplane flying field. The County charges \$6.00 on weekends and holidays for park access. Showing your LAR&R membership card or NRA card and expressing intent of rifle range destination will waive fee.

ELIGIBILITY: Entry is open to members and non-members of the NRA. CRPA membership is mandatory. Be sure to indicate your CRPA member number, CRPA membership expiration date, your NRA member number and your NRA outdoor 3P classification on your SR-1 registration form.

CLASSIFICATION: NRA 3-P classification will be used. Unclassified competitors may use their temporary scorebook assigned classification, or will fire in the Master class.

CRPA MEMBERSHIP: Forms are available at the ranges and non-members may join the CRPA on the day of the match. Adult memberships are \$22, Juniors \$5. Must be a CRPA member at the time of the match.

Competitors will be called to the line at 8:30 a.m.. There will be a preparation period starting at 8:45 a.m.. Shooting will begin at 9:00 a.m..

CRPA & LAR&R CLUB AWARDS: CRPA California Bear trophy will be awarded to the State Champion. High Junior in the Grand Aggregate will receive the title of Junior State Champion and a plaque. Club awards the top three competitors of match 4 and match 5 will receive Gold, Silver and Bronze medals. Half of the entry fees will be paid out to the winners of each match. Juniors will not receive any money for this match, their entry fees are paid by the CRPA.

TOURNAMENT RESULTS: Will be mailed out to all competitors.

PRACTICE: The range will be open for practice from 8am - 2pm on the Friday before the tournaments on paper targets.
